





Ukrainian Venture Capital and Private Equity Association (UVCA) was founded in 2014.



The Invest in Ukraine Committee was set up to promote Ukraine's investment opportunities abroad, and create the image of our country as a country where modern innovative products are created by international standards.







UVCA held the first **Ukrainian PE&VC Summit** in December 2021 (in partnership with Founders League).

This summit brought together:

- Representatives of the top-20 venture and private equity funds,
- Well-known experts of the investment market of Ukraine,
- More than 200 guests, including private investors, fund managers and investment offices,
- Representatives of international financial organizations,
- Representatives of the government

The Alley of Startups presented the 10 best innovative projects in various fields: Software Development, Devices, Fintech, Big data, Logistics.







UVCA together with the Free Ukraine Foundation launched the «Support Ukrainian Startups NOW» program aiming to provide aid for startups and specialists that are a part of the Ukrainian startup community and whose innovative business needs help right now.

To date, more than 28 startups have received grants from the Program. On top of it, almost 100 startups were given opportunities to raise funds and receive additional assistance in their activities.

On October 14th, 2022, we held our first joint workshop with the EIF, **"How to Raise Funds with the EIF".**

UVCA has created the **"Ukraine Reconstruction and Recovery Plan"** and are working on it together with our European partners.

During our first joint workshop, founders and managers of Ukrainian VC/PE funds received information about the EIF, its current investment programs and products, its initiatives and opportunities, as well as best practices within existing programs.

We intend to hold a number of similar webinars with institutional investors in order to expand the cooperation of European and global investment funds with Ukrainian investment funds, financial managers and market experts.

UVCA Supervisory Board Chairman, on rebuilding Ukraine and the steps that UVCA is taking to achieve it from his presentation:

"Rebuilding Ukraine: fostering green growth through investment"

- How can foreign financiers and UHNW families aid Ukraine in its ambitious green rebuild?
- How will Ukraine's start-up scene propel private ventures?
- And, are new regulatory policies and security guarantees for investors on the horizon?

Key aspects of economic reconstruction:

Prioritizing renewal and development of the manufacturing and service sectors. Foreign direct investments, grants, and loans from international organizations for business are necessary for a prompt renewal of the economy. Economic recovery of Ukraine will develop in parallel with **structural reforms** in its role as a candidate for membership in the European Union.

Attracting international aid for the recovery should take place by means of a trust to ensure transparency in its distribution.


The continuing military threat from Russia will require **security guarantees** for Ukraine from Western countries.



Description

The Fund of Funds funding is combined with a **matching investment** from other well performing funds as a LP into VC Funds. Currently, more than 10 funds are raising capital and FoF could invest from 30 to 50% as an anchor LP.

In Dec 2021, Ukrainian government committed 300M UAH (in the budget of Ministry of digital transformation) into FoF and welcome others institutional investors to join.



Platform for co-investments, joint ventures & public-private partnership (URP)

Direct co-investment opportunities via UVCA matching investment platform for joint ventures and greenfield projects with strategic investors

The heart of the platform is a **matchmaking opportunity** that allows to match dozens of prominent domestic projects and offers from Ukrainian entrepreneurs with foreign investors and strategic partners seeking for new opportunities and deals.
